The Government will make two thousand additional troops on the streets of Buenos Aires



The Government announced today that it will add to the safety prevention work two thousand new troops and as an inducement will be paid 1,000 pesos of surplus, announced today the Security Minister Nilda Garre.

The official presentation shared this week police equipment along with President Cristina Fernandez de Kirchner, on the forecourt of Government House.



"We will increase staffing in the streets and police stations in two thousand troops to deter crime and to address them if they are committed," stressed the minister, who specified that the 8374 personal-effective, "will receive a thousand plus weights. "

The President and the Minister noted the 110-kilometer zero patrol joined the Federal Police, equipped with latest technology

which allows, for example, patents scan vehicles and through consultation in line with a database, namely time if the vehicle has real arrest warrant.

The president addressed one of the patrol near the Deputy Commissioner of the Federal

Department Videos, Pedro Martinez, who showed him how to operate the touch-screen display to see the Register of recidivism and other demographic data bases.

Garre extended to "those 110 troopers will be added in not more than sixty days other ninety chosen from the existing fleet in order to add devices."

Chevrolet Monza These patrols are also equipped with cameras located in two modules that can capture 360 degrees, both day and night, and burn images to eventually give to judicial investigation.

The President visited it traveled a Mobile Command and Communications, which can communicate with other security forces and provincial police through a radio antenna 42 meters in height.

"We need a modern police force to improve the performance of the force," the minister agreed and submitted a hydro-lift telescopic, which will operate in complex cases of fires in buildings up to 18 floors, about 54 meters.

Cristina did not rise to hydro-lift but if you rode the flaming "Explosives Research Unit," a 9043 IVECO truck equipped to assist specialists in explosives.

Among the equipment highlights a robot caterpillar that can command a hundred yards, climb stairs and elevate your clip up to three meters.

Garre said that the robot is a development of an Argentinean engineer and has a lighted video scope about the specialist but keeping a safe distance.

As a political message, after the tour, the minister said that "with this material the police will be more efficient" and added that the distribution of the two thousand new police officers will patrol the streets according to the "crime map" has been made in each police station
